## UNITY DEMOCRATIC CLUB ENDORSES MORGAN EVERS IN DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY FOR NY 81<sup>ST</sup> ASSEMBLY

*Progressive political organization backs Evers and calls for ‘a new generation of leadership for working families in the Northwest Bronx’*

**BRONX, NEW YORK** – New York teacher and activist Morgan Evers received the unanimous endorsement of The Unity Democratic Club, the progressive political organization for the 81st Assembly in the Northwest Bronx.

“The Unity Dems is proud to endorse our very own Morgan Evers, a selfless and strong leader who we can trust, to be the next Assemblymember for the 81st District,” **said Marcelo Lopez, President of The Unity Democratic Club.** “It’s time to usher in a new generation of leadership who will actually fight for working families in the Northwest Bronx. As a growing multi-ethnic and multi-generational coalition focused on community and civic action in the Bronx, the Unity Dems will work to ensure we send Morgan to Albany and the incumbent packing after three decades in power.”

If elected, Evers, who is visually impaired, will be the first blind woman to serve in the New York state legislature.

Evers co-founded The Unity Democratic Club in 2022 with a group of breakaway progressives from the Benjamin Franklin Democratic Club after she and a slate of newcomers won elected party seats. Evers served as New York State Committee member for the 81st Assembly District during the 2022 to 2024 term.

Evers is challenging 16-term incumbent Jeffrey Dinowitz, a foreclosure auction attorney who was elected to the seat in 1994, and secretary of the Bronx Democratic Party.

The 81st Assembly District encompasses Kingsbridge, Riverdale, Spuyten Dyvil, Van Cortlandt Village, and parts of Norwood, Wakefield and Woodlawn in the Bronx.
